## MICHAEL R. TORIELLO

Mr. Michael R. Toriello is the Deputy Base Civil Engineer at Davis-Monthan AFB since April 1988. From July 2011 to July 2014 Mr Toriello did a three year overseas tour at Aviano AB, Italy.

In July 2011 Michael R. Toriello was selected to fill the position as Deputy Commander for the 31<sup>st</sup> Mission Support Group, Aviano Air Base Italy. In that capacity he supported all the mission support and logistics functions for base community of nearly 10,000. This includes the operation of six squadrons: Civil Engineers, Communications, Contracting, Force Support, Logistics Readiness and Security Forces Squadrons. Together these units ensure the 31<sup>st</sup> Fighter Wing's ability to mobilize, deploy, and employ combat airpower anywhere, while sustaining the base's in-place missions, its infrastructure, its workforce and families.

Mr. Toriello was born in Youngstown, Ohio and graduated with a Bachelor of Engineering degree from Youngstown State University in 1970. After graduation, he served 4 years in the United States Air Force, 3½ years of which were in the 355th Civil Engineer Squadron Programs and Engineering Branches at DMAFB, Arizona. Mr. Toriello received his Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Arizona in January 1976, and is a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Ohio.



In January 1976, Mr. Toriello was selected by Headquarters Strategic Air Command, Offutt AFB, NE to work as a Civil Structural Engineer. In February 1979, he was picked by the Air Force Engineering and Services Center staff to work as a Civil Structural Engineer. During his 2-year tenure, Mr. Toriello successfully implemented AFM 91-36, Built-up Roof Management Program, for the entire Air Force.

In March 1981, Mr. Toriello was selected to fill the position of DBCE at Williams AFB, Arizona. During his seven years at Williams he was responsible for significant improvements to base facilities and the infrastructure. In April 1988, Mr. Toriello was selected as the Deputy Base Civil Engineer (GM-14) at Davis-Monthan AFB (DMAFB), Arizona. Since his employment at Davis-Monthan, Mr. Toriello has developed a comprehensive, long-range facility use plan consolidating mission requirements, eliminating old wood buildings, and upgrading base infrastructure. He has worked with the State of Arizona, Pima County, and the City of Tucson extensively on a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) defining specific land use on the southeast end of the base runway out to 50,200 feet. The JLUS land use recommendations were adopted by the City and County and is recognized by HQ AF/A7 as the most successful JLUS in the Air Force. Mr. Toriello recently worked the facility beddown for the new Combat Search and Rescue units, the award of a 14.5 megawatt solar renewable energy power purchase agreement, and a three-year successful housing privatization at DMAFB. He was the Project Officer and Team Chief for the 2010 Chief of Staff Team Excellence Award (CSTE) for the DMAFB Charter School Working Group. Mr. Toriello briefed the CSETA panel of judges in Washington D.C. on the first Charter School in the Air Force at DMAFB winning the CSTE, Air Force Best Practice, and special recognition from the Chief of Staff of the Air Force General Norton Schwartz.

Mr. Toriello is married to the former Jane Grable of Tucson, Arizona. They have three sons, Nicholas, Ryan, and Andrew.
